Our New Locaiton: A Haven of Excellence

Our new location encompasses 180 acres of pristine wilderness, providing our beloved wolf residents with ample space to thrive. This expansion allows us to plan for endless possibilities to further enrich the lives of these magnificent animals. Here are some of the exciting additions and improvements:

Headquarters Buildings:

We now have a headquarters building that includes running water from a newly installed well, electricity, a hot water heater, a three compartment sink, stainless steel tables, thawing refrigerator, and a meat grinder that serves as the heart of our feeding operations, ensuring that we can continue to provide the best nutrition for our wolves.

Onsite Caretaker:

We have a caretaker who now lives on the property to assist in ensuring 24/7 care and safety throughout the night at our facility.

Deck Pens in All Habitats:

Each wolf now has their own deck pen, including a roof, offering them a personal space to relax and enjoy the fresh air and their own feeding station.

Starlink WiFi:

Our improved connectivity allows us to have sitewide communications with staff and volunteers throughout the property.

New Security Cameras in Each Habitat:

With new cameras, we can closely monitor our wolf residents to ensure their safety and well-being as well as to monitor the security and safety throughout the property.

~0.5 Acre Natural Habitats for Each Wolf Pair:

We've created spacious, natural habitats for each wolf pair, giving them the freedom to roam and explore.

Breathtaking Views:

Our new location offers breathtaking views of the surrounding natural beauty, creating a serene and inspiring environment for our wolves.



We're Working Towards Even More:

Our journey is far from over, and we have exciting plans for the future. Future plans include building a meat processing building with an attached walk-in freezer; renovating the headquarters to provide an office for staff, a room for volunteers to stage, a shower, small kitchenette and a small vet room for routine exams and minor procedures. The latter helps minimize stress and anxiety of having to take the animals offsite to a clinic. We're also installing a state-of-the art Green Flush restroom for visitors, building a pavilion for visitors to gather for scheduled tours, and provide expanded parking for

visitors. We are eager to open our doors to the public for scheduled tours with our magnificent wolves and witness the incredible progress we've made.

As we look back at our journey and ahead to the future, we are filled with gratitude for your support and commitment to our mission. 


Qualified Charitable Donations


